English Access Micro-scholarship Programme

- As part of International collaboration a two year programme for gaining English language skills (Listening/ Speaking/Reading/ Writing) at after school hours was launched in November 2007 for socially and financially under privileged children of Aligarh Muslim University Schools sponsored by American Centre, US Embassy, New Delhi.
- The Programme completed after two year phase (2014-16) with the enrolment of 200 AMU school children.
- The children are also exposed to learning opportunities in personality development sessions, reading books, hands on computer proficiency, educational trips and special enhancement activities in leadership camps and summer camps across the world

Centre for Academic Leadership and Education Management

For ensuring excellence in teacher education of the Minority Managed Degree Colleges of India, the Centre for Academic Leadership and Education Management (CALEM) was sanctioned by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, New Delhi in September 2015 to the UGC Human Resource Development Centre, AMU, Aligarh under the PMMMNMTT (Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission on Teacher Training) Scheme of the MHRD. CALEM aims at revitalizing Minorities Managed Degree Colleges (MMDCs) by way of organizing course for the faculty members of MMDCs. Upto 09 August 2016 a total number of 26 courses were held in MMDCs in all parts of the country and 1168 teachers were trained on various topics of Academic Leadership.
